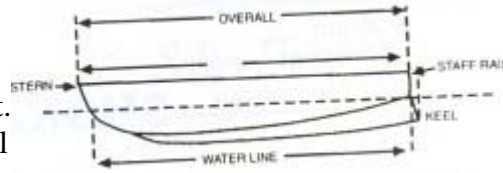


## Work Boats Only

---

1. Registration of Boats takes place from Monday July 25th to Saturday July 31st 2005. There will be no Registration on Sunday.
2. Only Foreign Boats arriving late will be registered on Sunday before 9am.
3. Numbers and Flags MUST be displayed on the PORT side of the boats for easy identification.
4. All Boats should be at racing venue one Hour before the start of each race.
5. Boats will be started according to class with the smallest first and the largest last.
6. The Race course (Subject to change) will be made available at least two weeks before the races.
7. Small open boats with Centerboards will not be allowed to race with them or race in a higher class. Oars and Engines must not be used.
8. Boatmen not wearing the committee Sponsored T-shirts provided will lose a maximum of five points for each race.
9. Failure to comply with any of the committee's rules will result in disqualification.
10. The Committee has adopted a standard for measuring of all boats. This measurement will be used to measure all boats in Competition. See diagram above.



Boats will be placed in the following Classes:

Long Open B	24 - 27 ft	
Long open A	28 ft	
Small Deck Sloops	28 - 32 ft	
Large Deck Sloop	Over 32 ft	

There are Two Categories for Boats:

### **Traditional Boats (Wood) -**

- 28' 6" Max. Length
- Must have Double Ender Curved Hull design (No Chime)

## Carriacou Regatta Festival

- Sprit Rig (Any Material)

### **Non-Traditional Boats:**

- Max. 28' 6"
- Not having any of the qualities of a traditional Boat.

### **Starting**

There will be three races in the series. The first begins on Sunday at 10:00am with the second at 2:00pm the same day and the final at 11am on Monday.

All races begin at Hillsborough except the First race on Sunday for the Stern Boats and Large & Small Deck Sloops which begins at Windward.

The Round-D-Island race on Saturday begins from Windward at 09:30am and the Long Open Saturday Race Begins at L'Esterre at 10am.

All shore start will begin behind the Regatta Jupa and Finish at the stake boat.

Other starts will be between the committee Boat (Stake Boat) and the Jetty

Classes will start at approx. 5 minutes intervals, which will be marked by a horn. Each Class will approach the start line after the class before it has started.

Instruction on the time of start will be issued from a loud hailer aboard the stake boat and on shore.

Touching of the stake boat and/or Buoys are prohibited. A total of four points will be lost if touching can be proven.

A dispute committee will be set up to handle all complains which Must be made as soon as it is practically possible. The committee will have the final say in any matter.

Anchorage for all other boats will be North of 120 29" 23" N and South of 120 28" 94' S.
